**Case Management and Counseling**— Provides practical and emotional support to Deaf and Hard of Hearing people and their families

**Regional Infant Hearing Program (RIHP)** - Provides education, support and advocacy to families who have infants identified as having hearing loss

**Deaf Kids and Teens Club**—provides Deaf Children and teens the opportunity to socialize with their peers without language or cultural barriers

**KODA Camp**—an opportunity for hearing children of Deaf adults to interact with others who share the same experiences of living with parents who are Deaf

**Deaf Off Drugs and Alcohol (DODA)** - a grant funded project to improve alcohol and drug treatment services for people who are Deaf or Hard of hearing.
